### Domicile found despite ample time out of state

Despite evidence that a Chapter 7 debtor spent much of his time working in other states where he maintained residences, a federal judge has found the debtor established that his domicile remained in Massachusetts and thus could take advantage of the state's homestead exemption.



### Charges dropped vs. leaders of Holyoke veterans' home

A Hampden Superior Court judge dismissed criminal neglect charges on Nov. 22 against two former leaders of a veterans' home where nearly 80 veterans died after contracting the coronavirus, saying there was a lack of evidence that their actions led to the deaths.
